Measuring website usage (Google Analytics)

We use Google Analytics software to collect information about how you use speenergy.com.

Google Analytics stores information about:

- what you click on while you're visiting the site

We don't collect or store your personal information (e.g. your name or address) so this information can't be used to identify who you are.

We don't allow Google to use or share our analytics data.

Google Analytics sets the following cookies:

GDS_successEvents & GDS_analyticsTokens	These help us identify how you use our website so we can make the site better	4 months
